



Obtaining Certified Dispositions

A certified disposition is an official document describing your arrest or detention, the charge, and what happened during your court trial. Immigration requests certified dispositions to determine a person’s eligibility for citizenship.

Please refer to the chart below to learn how and where to obtain a certified disposition.

Como obtener una disposición certificada

Una **disposición certificada** es un documento oficial describiendo su arresto o detención, el cargo, y lo que pasó durante la corte. Inmigración requiere las disposiciones certificadas para ayudar a determinar la elegibilidad de un inmigrante que quiere hacerse ciudadano. En Ingles, una disposición certificada es “certified disposition.”
